Terms and Conditions

- Acceptance on the course is at the discretion of the Principal.
- You are bound by these terms and conditions and are understood fully to have accepted them when you register.
- We reserve the right to change dates, locations and, prior to the start date, cancel a course.
- It is important to inform the office well in advance if you are unable to attend a scheduled date so we can provide you with alternate dates; we cannot be held responsible if you are unable to attend a replacement date.
- If students fail to attend one or more sessions they must speak to the principal by phone within two weeks of the missed session(s) in order to be given alternative classes.
The school shall not be liable under the/this agreement in respect of any of the following: a) Any indirect or consequential loss (including, for the avoidance of doubt, any economic loss) resulting from breach of contract, negligence or any other tort on the part of the school or any of its officers, employees or agents, and b) The termination of this agreement in accordance with its terms c) Any failure in its performance of this agreement (including but not limited to failure of provision of the service/lessons/whatever..) caused by events outside its reasonable control "
- Students are required immediately during the session to inform the tutor if they find any aspect of the practical sessions sensitive. The student accepts all responsibility for the pressure used on them during treatments by a member of staff or by a fellow student.
- LSR and its staff cannot be held responsible for any reactions caused by a reflexology treatment given by a member of staff or a student
- You will require access to the internet and use of an email address to print work on occasions.
- All fees are payable on the day of enrolment unless otherwise agreed.
- No refunds can be given on deposits, exam fees and course fees, or for sessions unattended for whatever reason. Those who miss part of the course for good reasons will be offered substitute replacement dates at the principal's discretion.
- Keep the school well informed with any illnesses or barriers to learning. We will endeavour to meet your learning needs but cannot be held liable in any way if LSR is unable to meet your requirements.
- Contact the tutor immediately and in writing at the session with any troubles, religious requirements, personality clashes and special needs. Students accept that the school does not hold any responsibility for these.
- You are required to become members of The Association of Reflexologists on the first day of the course, which costs £36 – paid to the AoR . Your membership gives you area group information, a quarterly journal and workshops featuring guest speakers from the UK and world-wide.
- Students will be required to take our appointed persons first aid course which costs £85.

Course Dates

The course and centrally set examinations generally last for ten months, with class dates on Saturdays and/or Sundays (exception of the weekday courses). Hours of attendance are from 10.00am to approximately 6.00pm. Tutors are available in the mornings for one to one tutorials and assistance.

Course Fees

The course fee is £995, which includes all your course material. The deposit at the time of booking is £160 and either before or on the first day of the course the remaining payable amount is £835.

Examination

In the later part of the course you will be able to sit and be assessed on a mock examination so you can practice your exam techniques. The written examination will consist of a two and a half hour theory paper which you are required to continuously study over the nine months. You will need to have completed the required six case studies over the course, which involves commitment of time and research. Case studies are continuously assessed during the course and the Association of Reflexologist can verify work. There is an examination fee of £140, which is payable on session three.
